APPLICATION FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SCHOLARSHIP
SHERIFF LEROY MOODY SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship Guidelines:

This scholarship is awarded to high school seniors majoring in criminal justice.

Qualifications:

1. Applicant must be a 2023 graduate from any high school within San Patricio County.
2. The applicant must have a 2.5 GPA at the time the application is submitted.
3. The applicant must submit their application by **April 21, 2023 TO the Sheriff's Office at 300 N. Rachel or P.O. Box 1382, Sinton, Texas 78387** .
4. Application must include three (3) teacher/community leader recommendations.
5. Must submit an essay of 200-300 words as to why you plan to pursue a career in criminal justice.
6. Must also include a resume listing extracurricular activities such as community service, clubs, jobs, church, etc.
7. The applicant must appear before the Scholarship Committee for an interview at the scheduled time in order to qualify.

Payment of Scholarship:

Payment of the scholarship award is to be made in two payments, one per semester. In order to receive your scholarship, you must provide proof of college admittance with full time status and enrollment in criminal justice classes. At least 12 semester hours must be completed with a grade point average of 3.0 or better, enrollment in criminal justice classes and full time status admittance to qualify for the second half of the scholarship.

It will be the responsibility of the recipient to contact Sheriff Oscar Rivera's office to receive his/her check within 30 days after the semester begins. No scholarships will be awarded after the 30 days.
